Programme Highlights

This technical talk will present details of the design and construction of the site formation works associated with the new international cruise terminal project being undertaken by the Hong Kong Government as part of the re-development of the former Kai Tak International Airport runway. The site formation works primarily comprise the construction of an 850m long two-berth piled quay deck design to accommodate Mega-class cruise vessels to around 220,000 DWT. The quay deck adjoins the iconic cruise terminal building, being constructed concurrently under a separate works contract.

Ian Muir is Director responsible for the management of the URS/Scott Wilson Maritime business in Hong Kong and is Maritime Business Unit Head for the Asia Pacific region. He is a geotechnical specialist with twenty four years experience in civil engineering practice and emphasis on maritime works. He has been based in Hong Kong and employed by URS/Scott Wilson since 1993. He is currently leading the firm’s Maritime Section and is Deputy Project Director for the Kai Tak Cruise Terminal Site Formation Project.
