

Technical Visit to Wan Chai Development Phase II

Date, Time & Venue

Saturday, **29 October 2011**, 9:00 am to 12:00 noon. Assembly venue will be advised to successful applicants.

Programme Highlights

The key purpose of Wan Chai Development Phase II (WDII) is to provide land at Wan Chai North and North Point for the construction of the Central - Wan Chai Bypass and Island Eastern Corridor Link ("the CWB"). Land formed under the project will be developed as a world-class waterfront promenade joining that at the new Central waterfront for public enjoyment.

Major elements of the WDII project include:-

- 1. Formation of land along the existing coastline at Wan Chai North and North Point for the construction of the CWB;
- 2. Reprovisioning of affected existing facilities including cross harbour water mains, submarine sewage outfall pipelines, ferry piers, cooling water pumping systems and a salt water pumping station:
- 3. Extending Road P2 at Central Reclamation Phase III to Wan Chai North and re-aligning the existing Hung Hing Road;
- 4. Modification of existing roads for connection with the slip roads of the CWB tunnel; and
- 5. Construction of new pedestrian linkages to the new waterfront.

In this visit, participants can understand the scope of WDII Project and appreciate the on-going construction activities such as seawall construction and associated land formation works, construction of CWB tunnel and reprovisioning of affected existing facilities.
