# 2012 Photo Competition

### Highlights

Following the success of the EAHK 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Photo Competition, we are running the Competition again this year. EAHK Members are cordially invited to submit photos.

Photo submissions will show the diversity of Engineering Work and Projects within Hong Kong and will be judged on engineering interest, photographic and artistic merit. Photos do not need to be of the Members own Projects.

Winning photos will be printed in a 2013 Souvenir Calendar for our members and friends. The Best Photo will be on the cover and the 12 runner-up photos will decorate each month. A judging panel, including a number of past EAHK Presidents, will review the submitted entries to determine the winners.

### Entry Requirements

- Photos should highlight any aspect of Engineering in Hong Kong and taken by the Member any time from January 2010.
- Computer generated images will not be accepted.
- Photos should avoid commercial elements as much as possible (e.g. company names).
- Photos can be in black & white or colour and may be taken on film or digital cameras but only digital image submissions accepted (film or slides need to be scanned). Post processing is encouraged to enhance the photo quality.
- Photos will preferably be in landscape orientation (best for the Calendar).
- Members may submit up to 5 photos for consideration.
- Members may resubmit non winning photos from the previous year competition provided they were taken after January 2010.
- Members must obtain any model releases or company approvals (if applicable) allowing EAHK to use the photos in the Calendars and elsewhere.
- Members retain copyright of their photos but, by submission and agreement to these requirements, allow EAHK to use the photos however it wishes in relation to EAHK activities.
- Submitted photos must be in standard jpeg format and resized to 1280 pixels wide (winners will be contacted for higher resolution original images).
- Photo submissions, including titles in the file name, MUST be sent electronically to the Secretariat of EAHK by **31<sup>st</sup> October 2012 via email**

### Prizes

The Best Photo photographer will be awarded a cash prize of HK\$5,000 and the 12 runner-up photographers will be awarded a cash prize of HK\$1,000 each. A single photographer may win up to two prizes at the determination of the judging panel.
