Programme Highlights

The Central Wanchai Bypass (CWB) is a strategic east-west trunk road at the north shore of Hong Kong Island linking Central and North Point. On completion, it will alleviate the traffic problem in the Gloucester Road / Harcourt Road / Connaught Road Central, and will improve the traffic flow in the Hung Hom Cross-harbour tunnel. The CWB is a 4.5 km long 3-lane 2-way trunk road of which 3.7 km is in underground tunnels. The Works also involve permanent reclamation in the Wan Chai area and a temporary reclamation in the Causeway Bay typhoon shelter. Work commenced in December 2009 and is expected to be completed in 2017.

The speaker will briefly discuss the various construction methods to suit site constraints, and the challenges encountered. He will also introduce the innovative air purification system after the CWB tunnels are put into use.
