### **Programme Highlights**

With the launch of the new BEAM Plus EB 2.0 rating scheme retro-commissioning, re-commissioning and continuous commissioning (as well as monitoring-based commissioning) become an increasingly important aspects of green building. This seminar will provide an overview of the commissioning process for existing buildings and the major standards that govern it.

Also, the seminar will provide details on the latest BEAM Plus EB standard requirements with regards to existing buildings commissioning and practical applications and benefits from existing building commissioning. Moreover, reference to other international green building ratings systems with regards to existing building commissioning will be provided.

### **Speaker: Ir. Rumen Yordanov**

Rumen (MSc, RPE, CEng, CEnv, MCIBSE, MASHRAE, MSEE, LEED AP BD+C, BEAM Pro) is a director of Asian European Engineering (AEE) Ltd, a leading authority in existing building sustainability. Rumen has more than 12 years of sustainability and design experience in both Europe and Asia-Pacific. He is the current Technical Committee Chair of Platinum Hong Kong and LEED International Roundtable Representative. Rumen has been named by ASHRAE one of top 5 new faces of engineering for 2014. Rumen is also a winner of the first prize of the international Passive House Design Competition 2012 and second prize at Sustainable Architecture 2020-8.
