Programme Highlights:

Complementary roles of Greater Bay Area (GBA) Cities will provide opportunities for Hong Kong

The likely economic trajectory as “pretty straightforward.” The GBA consisting of Hong Kong, Shenzhen, Dongguan, Guangzhou, Foshan, Zhongshan, Zhuhai, Huizhou, Zhaoqing, Jiangmen and Macau will contain the main administration, technology and advance manufacturing, as well as high-end service centres.

Elevator Technology (Intelligent innovation)

The contents of the visit covered the Liftcore’s international R&D team working under German management developed the world most intelligent technology for elevators – Liftcore’s control and regulation technology is more than just today’s usual elevator control concepts with their classic peripheral components.
