Content	Under the built-environment of Hong Kong very often the construction of buildings may involve substantial amount of slope works forming part of the project components. This happens in particular for those projects in larger scale and with complicated site condition nearby. Making use of more than 20 years of experience involving in the study of construction of such kind of projects both locally and in China, Ir. Raymond Wong will highlight the construction features and challenges encountered in such projects. Illustration will also be made using actual examples and show how the works are to be set-up, organized and with all other work challenges tackled.
Speaker and brief biography	Ir. Raymond Wong Wai-man Ir Wong obtained his membership in CIOB and HKIE dating back to the 1980s. He is now serving as a full-time teaching staff in the Division of Building Science & Technology at the City University of Hong Kong. He is also an independent researcher works on his own resources since he entered City University in mid-1990s, with major research focus on large-scale construction and infrastructure projects, urban studies and China development studies. Ir Wong has developed a web-based information archive since late 1990s to share some of his study outputs with general public.
