Technical Visit Marine Bridges in TKO, 8 Feb 2020

About the Technical Visit

The purpose of this Technical Visit is to provide the participants a chance to view road bridge construction in the open sea. The visit will start with a briefing of the location and layout of the marine bridges forming part of the Tseung Kwan O- Lam Tin Tunnel project, currently under construction.

Then the Tour Leader will go to several viewing platforms where he will explain the piling operation, construction of pile caps and marine piers. He will also discuss the problems encountered during the Works, and the practical solutions to overcome the problems.

Mr. CHENG Tak Sum has over 40 years of experience in heavy civil construction covering marine bridge, roads and drainage, tunnels and site reclamation. He has served various senior supervisory and management positions in top local contractors, and is a well-known engineer in the construction industry.
